MILEAGE OPTIONS

DAY ONE OPTIONS: You may choose the Short Route (40 miles), Regular Route (80 miles) or the Century Route (100 miles).

DAY TWO OPTIONS: — On Sunday, you may choose the Regular Route (70 miles) or another Century Route (100 miles) as you ride to the finish line at Clever.

DOUBLE CENTURY LOOP: This could be the physical challenge some of you are looking for! Century routes are optional on each day. We want you to enjoy the ride while raising money to fight MS in the Ozarks!

OVERNIGHT ACCOMODATIONS
